The Left's Radical Push To Allow Abortion On Demand Up Until The Moment Of Birth

The left is working to revoke state laws that protect life while trying to mandate abortion on demand up until the moment of birth.

RADICAL ABORTION OVERREACH

- Liberal officials are working to eliminate any abortion limitations, challenging commonsense state laws and pushing Federal legislation to force their radical agenda on the entire country.
- As the Supreme Court evaluates the *Dobbs* case, liberals in the Senate are looking to vote on an abortion on demand bill that would <u>codify</u> abortions up until the very moment of birth.
- This extreme legislation <u>prohibits</u> any state level abortion regulations to protect life a radical proposal that the American people clearly don't support.
 - The bill would even nullify state restrictions on discriminatory abortions, allowing abortion based on the race or gender of the fetus.
- The left is pushing an aggressive <u>federal takeover</u> of abortion policy that tries to eliminate decades of policy written by duly elected state legislatures.

RECKLESSLY OUT OF TOUCH WITH THE AMERICAN PEOPLE

- Polling consistently shows that Americans, Independents, and even many Democrats do not support abortion on demand.
 - o In a 2021 AP-NORC poll, <u>80%</u> of Americans said that abortion should usually be illegal in the third trimester and 65% said it should be during the second trimester.
 - o According to an AP Poll, "just 23% say abortion in general should be legal in all cases."
 - "A strong majority of voters oppose unrestricted, abortion on demand, throughout pregnancy," <u>according</u> to a Susan B. Anthony List/OnMessage Inc. survey.
 - 71% of Americans support legal limits on abortion, according to a 2022 Knights Of Columbus/Marist Poll.
- This radical legislation would forbid many commonsense abortion limitations that enjoy widespread support.
 - 64% of all Americans, including 71% of Independents and 55% of Democrats support requiring doctors who perform abortions to have <u>hospital admitting privileges</u> according to a 2019 NPR/PBS Newshour/Marist Poll.

FALLING FURTHER BEHIND THE REST OF THE WORLD

- The United States is just one of seven countries in the world that currently <u>allows</u> elective abortion past 20 weeks gestation.
 - The left's new bill, permitting abortion until birth, would push the United States even further towards the radical fringe.
- No European country allows elective abortion through all nine months of pregnancy, as liberals in the Senate are attempting to codify into federal law with this measure.
 - Just <u>three</u> European nations, Iceland, Netherlands, and Sweden, permit elective abortion past 15 weeks.
- The United States is joined by the likes of North Korea and China in allowing elective abortion past 20 weeks.

•	More than 75% of countries that allow elective abortion without restriction <u>do not</u> permit elective abortion after 12 weeks gestation.
